
**New Business** –


- Resolution 2024-004 – Juneteenth – Request to read by Nance. Mayor Vandegrift read the resolution. Council member Raglin voiced her appreciation for the City of Midway to recognize and continue the festival for future generations. First motion to approve Raglin/Second Mason, All in favor 6-0
- Rumpke contract three-year extension. First motion to approve Gallagher/Second Raglin, All in favor 6-0
- Juneteenth festival additional requests: Music to be played during setup 6pm-10pm Friday night and for the stage to be set up after 5pm on Friday. First motion to approve Hicks/Second Raglin, All in favor 6-0
- Bourbon and Blues update from Cortney Neikirk. Vendors will check in at the corner of Gratz. There is a new option for parking.
