Approval of Minutes:

- Special Meeting Minutes, January 26, 2026 – council member Hall was absent for this meeting. First motion to approve was from VanSteenbergh/Second by Simoff All voting in favor 5-0

New Business –

- Midway Fire Department Recruitment – the volunteer fire department is looking for candidates to maintain fifteen as well as a few reserves to receive state fire aid annually.
- FEMA reimbursement for storms assistance – All of Woodford County and its city's declared a state of emergency for April 3 – 6, 2025. This declaration allowed the City of Midway to apply for government assistance to repair flood damaged city owned properties. The Mayor described that applications have been submitted for two different sections of town. One is a sewer line that crosses over Lees Creek. The second is Newton Street. Once FEMA determines eligibility, the decision will be shared.
