

City of Midway, City Council Regular Meeting
Monday, July 6, 2026, 5:30 p.m.

The Regular Meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift. The following Council Members were present: Logan Nance, Ian VanSteenbergh, Steve Simoff, Patrick Hall and Mary Raglin. Also present: Assist. City Clerk Sonya Conner, City Attorney Sharon Gold, VPD rep T. Conner, and EOC rep Crabtree. Council Member Kaye Nita Gallagher was absent.

No Public Comment

Josh Meeder – Midway resident said this would be the last meeting he attends. He thanked the council and mayor for everything they've done for the city and that he loves this town and he will miss everyone.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Budget Workshop #2, Tuesday, June 9, 2026 – Motion to approve by Council Member Nance, seconded by Council Member VanSteenbergh. Motion carried 4-0. Council Member Nance abstained due to being absent.
Special Meeting Minutes June 11, 2026 – Motion to approve by Council Member Hall, seconded by Council Member Nance. Motion carried 5-0.
Regular Meeting Minutes June 15, 2026 – Motion to approve by Council Member Nance, seconded by Council Member VanSteenbergh, with the change that Council Members Raglin and Hall were present for that meeting. Motion carried 5-0

New Business

Financing for new city dump truck. Motion to accept bid from John Jones Auto Group for a Dodge Ram in the amount of \$82,827.50 by Council Member Simoff, seconded by Council Member Hall. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Vandegrift discussed how the Kentucky State Department of Transportation does not allow golf carts on state roads. There are exceptions during festivals with police presence for traffic control. They are also not permitted on roads with speed limits higher than 35mph. There are strict rules that determine that the carts need to be street legal.

Cortney Niekirk and Zach Rankin with Midway Merchants Association were present and asked if an Ordinance comes about to ban golf carts, they ask for an exception for festivals.

Others that voiced opinion regarding use of golf carts were John Maybriar, Miller Benson, Joyce Land, David & Sherry Joseph, Michael Hunter, and Danielle Jostes. Mayor Vandegrift recommends appointing a committee at the next meeting to look into this further.

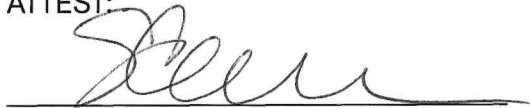
Motion to adjourn by Council Member Raglin, seconded by Council Member VanSteenbergh. Motion carried 5-0.
